Exemptions for Homeowners (RSA153:36) The Plumbing Licensing requirements do not apply to an "owner or his/her agent who installs, repairs or replaces plumbing in his/her own residence." This only applies if the homeowner or his/her agent is actually installing the work. Homeowners who apply and are issued plumbing permits and then decide to contract with a licensed plumber for all or a portion of the work shall have the licensed plumber apply and obtain a plumbing permit for the work being done by the licensed plumber. The homeowner shall not obtain a plumbing permit and then have someone else (licensed or not) do the work under the permit obtained by the owner.
