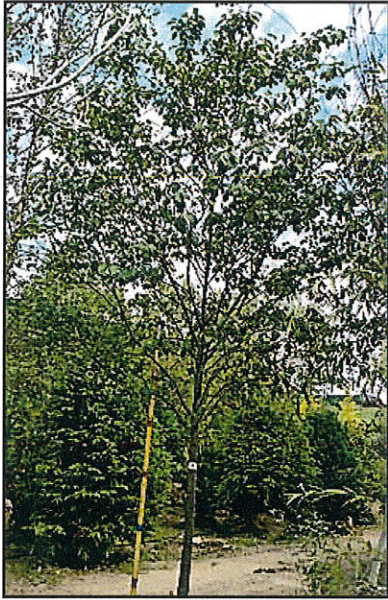

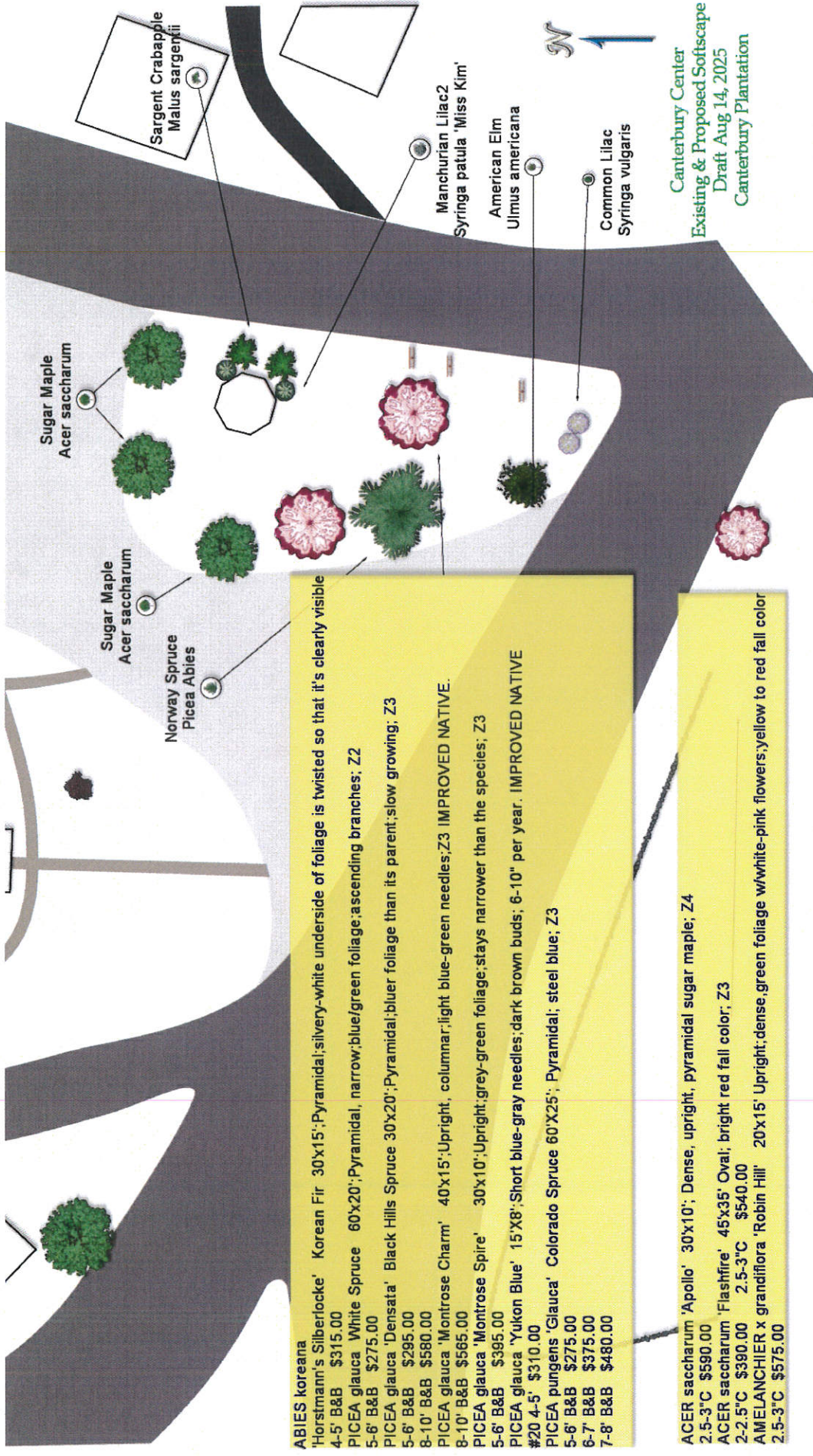

'Horstmann's Silberlocke' Korean Fir 30'x15'; Pyramidal; silvery-white underside of foliage is twisted so that it's clearly visible 4-5' B&B \$315.00
PICEA glauca White Spruce 60'x20'; Pyramidal, narrow; blue/green foliage; ascending branches; Z2 5-6' B&B \$275.00
PICEA glauca 'Densata' Black Hills Spruce 30'x20'; Pyramidal; bluer foliage than its parent; slow growing; Z3 5-6' B&B \$295.00

PICEA glauca 'Montrose Charm' 40'x15'; Upright, columnar; light blue-green needles; Z3 IMPROVED NATIVE. 8-10' B&B \$565.00
PICEA glauca 'Montrose Spire' 30'x10'; Upright; grey-green foliage; stays narrower than the species; Z3 5-6' B&B \$395.00
PICEA glauca 'Yukon Blue' 15'x8'; Short blue-gray needles; dark brown buds; 6-10" per year. IMPROVED NATIVE #20 4-5' \$310.00
PICEA pungens 'Glaucia' Colorado Spruce 60'x25'; Pyramidal; steel blue; Z3 5-6' B&B \$275.00
